

MORAL ACTS ARE SOCIAL ACTS

All moral acts are social acts but the converse is false.

Thus riding a bus and doing a spot of work are social acts

but not necessarily moral ones. (Only doing either for someone else without receiving or expecting reward would be

a moral act.) Hence all moral problems are social problems. The converse proposition (held by Dewey 19) is false.

DEF. A social act is a moral act iff committing it involves some sacrifice .
