There are three possible views on the relation between goodness and rightness:

- 1. There is no necessary relation: while some right actions have good consequences, others do not. (utilitarianism)
- 2. Consequentialism/ x is right iff it has good consequences.
- 3. <u>Deontologicalism</u>: right precedes good and can be evaluated in itself (independently of its consequences). E.g. Kant.
