## 14.- PROGRAMA ANALITICO

1. Simple present tense. Habits. Frequency and time adverbs. Present perfect tense. Simple past. Used to. "Television talk."
2. Infinitive and gerund constructions. Can; can't. Must; mustn't. First kind of conditional sentences. "Campaign." "The press."
3. Reported speech. Passive: present and simple past tenses. Relative clauses. Simple future tense. Second kind of conditional sentences. Give up; good at; start + 'ing'. "The Independent."
4. Present perfect continuous tense: using "how long". Present perfect using "how many/how much". Present perfect simple compared to present perfect continuous. "Summer holiday."



5. Hardly ever. Hardly any. Be used to + "ing"/noun. As soon as; until; when; after; before. Question tags. "Just the Job". "The city of London."
6. Compound adjectives. Infinitive constructions after adjectives. Prepositions and adverbs of place. Use of: but, although, however, in spite of, despite. "Stress: a human concern."
7. Relative clauses. Passive voice: infinitive, present continuous, present perfect. Causative constructions with "have" and "get". Make and let do something. "You have just given me my card."
8. Position of adverbs of manner, place and time. Requests and complaints. Apologies. Phrasal verbs. "Courtesy in the workplace."
9. Will and won't. Threats, promises, offers, etc. Future time clauses. Future continuous tense. Future perfect tense. Speculating: might/ could be + "ing". "All our children." "True tales of New York."
10. Past habits: would + infinitive. Future in the past. Reasons: as, because, since. Purpose: in order to, so that. "Home life: in the USA; in China."
11. Imaginary situations in the past. Third conditional sentences. Wishes for the present.. "The National Health Service." "100 years ago."
12. Regret about the past. Deductions: must/ can't have. Speculating: might/ could have. "The City of Everlasting Winter." "Making conversation: Do you need to change your style."
